



ACCEPTANCE OF CLIENT CREDIT CARDS

Important points and conditions relating to this Credit Card Charge:

- 1) **Wherever possible this Credit Card Charge Authority form should be signed by the cardholder.** If this is not possible, the guarantee on the bottom of this form must be signed by the Travel Agent for this charge to be processed.
- 2) **MasterCard and Visa Card:** A 1% Credit Card service fee will be added.
- 3) **American Express and Diners Club Card:** A 2.8% Credit Card service fee will be added.
